

## 2025 Car Show FAQ

### General Event Information

**1. What is the date, time, and location of the car show?**

- a. The 2025 Shoshone-Bannock Casino Hotel Car Show will take place on Saturday, July 26, 2025, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM at 777 Bannock Trail, Fort Hall, ID, United States, Idaho 83203. Gates open for participants at 6:00 AM and for spectators at 9:00 AM.

**2. How much are tickets, and where can I buy them?**

- a. Car Show Event is FREE to Spectators, Participants registering vehicles (see below).

**3. What types of cars will be displayed?**

- a. The show features a variety of vehicles, including classic cars, muscle cars, modern exotics, and modified vehicles.

**4. Is the event outdoors?**

- a. The event is outdoors in the west side Parking lot of Casino closest to RV Park. Check the weather forecast and dress accordingly.

**5. Is the event accessible for people with disabilities?**

- a. Yes, the venue is ADA-compliant with accessible parking, restrooms, and pathways.

**6. What amenities are available?**

- a. Food trucks, beverage stations, restrooms, first-aid tent, and seating areas are available. Patrons are allowed to bring their own lawn chairs.

**7. Can I bring pets?**

- a. Pets are not allowed.

**8. Is there parking for attendees?**

- a. Yes, free parking is available in designated lots near the venue. Follow signs or staff instructions. Carpooling or public transit is encouraged to reduce congestion.

**9. Will the event happen if it rains?**

- a. The show will proceed rain or shine. In case of severe weather, updates will be posted on Our Facebook Page 'Shoshone-Bannock Casino Hotel'.

**10. Can I take photos or videos?**

- a. Yes, photography and videography are encouraged for personal use! Share your moments on Facebook with #SBCHCarShow2025. Commercial use requires prior approval from organizers.

### **For Participants (Car Owners)**

#### **11. What are the requirements for my vehicle?**

- a. Vehicles must be in good condition (no leaks or safety hazards). All makes, models, and years are welcome, but they must fit into one of our categories (e.g., Classic, Modified, Import). Provide a brief description of your car during registration.

#### **12. When and where should I arrive?**

- a. Arrive between 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM on July 26 at the participant entrance. Volunteers will guide you to your assigned display spot.

#### **13. Can I choose where my car is displayed?**

- a. Display spots are assigned based on category and registration order. Special requests can be noted during registration but are not guaranteed.

#### **14. Do I need to stay with my car the entire time?**

- a. You're encouraged to stay near your vehicle during judging to answer questions from judges or attendees. You may leave afterward but must return by 3:45 PM for the awards ceremony or vehicle departure.

#### **15. Are there rules for displaying my car?**

- a. Yes, no burnouts, revving, or unauthorized modifications are allowed. Keep your area clean and follow volunteer instructions. Display signs (e.g., car details) are allowed but must be professional and secure.

#### **16. Will my car be judged, and how?**

- a. Judging will be based on criteria like originality, condition, and presentation. Special awards include Best in Show, Best Interior, and CEO's Choice.

#### **17. What do I get for participating?**

- a. All participants receive a commemorative dash plaque.

### **For Patrons (Attendees)**

#### **21. What activities are available besides viewing cars?**

- a. Enjoy live music, food trucks, and vendor booths (e.g., merchandise).

#### **22. Can I touch or sit in the cars?**

- a. No, touching or sitting in vehicles is prohibited unless the owner explicitly allows it. Respect barriers and follow volunteer instructions to ensure safety.

**23. Can I bring my own chairs or blankets?**

- a. Yes, folding chairs and blankets are welcome in designated spectator areas. Please keep pathways clear.

**24. Is there a lost and found?**

- a. Yes, visit the information booth near the Casino/Bingo Hall entrance for lost and found items.

**Safety and Logistics**

**27. What safety measures are in place?**

- a. Professional security, first-aid staff, Fire and EMS are on-site. Follow volunteer instructions and stay within designated areas.

**28. Are there restrooms and handwashing stations?**

- a. Yes, portable restrooms and handwashing stations are available at venue. Check the event map for locations.

**29. What should I bring?**

- a. Bring sunscreen, hats, or umbrellas for outdoor events, comfortable shoes, and cash/card for purchases.
