When not performing or recording, Toledo draws inspiration from the visual world as well, particularly Chicano art and its rich use of color, form, and cultural expression. That same appreciation for timeless style and emotional truth carries through her music.

With a voice rooted in tradition and a presence that speaks to both nostalgia and renewal, Trish Toledo continues to build a bridge between the music of the past and the listeners of today.
